

## Family Affair Campground—Rules & Regulations

1. Family camping includes 2 adults and biological, adopted or legal ward children under 18 years old. All others are considered visitors and must register at the office and pay the guest fee regardless of their length of stay and display a hang tag in their vehicle. Campers are responsible for the conduct of their visitors. Daily visiting fee \$5.00 per day per adult and \$7.00 overnight.
2. There is an additional charge for charging electric vehicles at a designated meter.
3. Speed limit on campground roads is 5 MPH. Strictly enforced.
4. Bicycles are to be back at the campsite by 8:30 PM. The playground and pool close at dusk.
5. Only 2 vehicles are permitted at a site. Visitor cars are to be parked in the public areas.
6. Campfires must be attended. Camper is responsible for damage caused by campfire.
7. Discharge of firearms or explosives of any type is not allowed, including air guns, archery equipment, slingshots, and fireworks, or any other weapons that can be construed as weapons of defense or offense.
8. Burning trash in fire ring is not permitted. All trash is to be taken to the dumpsters.
9. Pets are allowed but are required to be on a leash and kept quiet and controlled. You must clean up after your pet. Pets are not to be left unattended at campsite. Children are not to walk dogs that they cannot control. Rabies Vaccination required.
10. Camper should not deface or cut trees or plants for any reason. No gathering of firewood.
11. There is NO trespassing off campground property.
12. Electric golf carts are permitted. Driver must have valid driver's license. Golf carts driven after dark must have headlights.
13. Mini bikes, 3 & 4 wheelers and unlicensed motorcycles are prohibited.
14. Quiet hours are from 11:00 PM to 8:00 AM, and music or loud noise of any kind is not permitted. Music during non-quiet hours shall not be excessive, vulgar or demeaning.
15. The pond is for "catch and release" fishing only. No swimming in the pond.
16. Children under the age of 14 are not permitted to be in the pool area without an adult. A teenage sibling does not qualify as an adult. Swimmers must wear a bathing suit (no cut-offs), no food, gum, or beverages inside the pool area. Horse play, running and diving are strictly prohibited.
17. Check-in time is 2:00 PM. Check-out time is noon. No rain checks or weather-related refunds.
18. Partial hook-up includes one use at the dump station. Additional fee of \$20 for more than one use.
19. The management of FAC reserves the right to revoke or terminate any camping permit for the violation of these rules.
